In order to apply for this scholarship, a student must: attend or plan to attend college in Nebraska be a high school senior have attended high school in Nebraska.

Other Info:

Any Nebraska high school senior may participate. If selected, the high school senior must graduate at the end of the academic year. Recipient(s) will be notified if they won on Veteran's Day the year prior to their graduation. The amount is \$2,000. Given a tie, two students will receive a \$1,000 each.

Selection Criteria:

The applicant should submit a typed essay about an honorably discharged veteran. The title of the essay should be "Why this Nebraska veteran should be recognized and honored." The title should appear at the top of the essay. The essay should not exceed 1,000 words. Include a typed cover sheet with your name. If the honored veteran is deceased and buried at Fort McPherson National Cemetery (located in Maxwell, Nebraska), provide the grave number and mapped location. Selection will be based on grammar, punctuation, and quality of essay. Counselors will select the top two essays from their school and submit them to the North Platte Public Library, Attn: Vada Kinman Oldfield Scholarship, 120 West 4th Street, North Platte, NE 69101. No entries will be returned. All submitted entries will be filed for reference in the North Platte Public Library. The decision of the judges is final.
